"I bought the house for the opportunity to live beside water and look out every day at the river, fields and trees. It's like living in a nature reserve. Turtle nesting every June where snapping turtles come out onto the dry sunny areas beside the street and lay their eggs, and baby turtles hatch in late August. Foxes, deer, otters, ducks and geese!"

I can carry the canoe to the river for paddling. I have paddled April May and September October when the water level in the river is good.

Carp has a post office, LCBO, pharmacy, bakery, convenience store and library not to mention one of the best medical centres in the west end as well as an elementary school."
